Brittnay Cross, as TFTGC's Program Director, has overall authority for all TFTGC programming and will directly supervise you in your role. Your specific duties include the following:

- With direction from the Site Director, assist with:
  - Set up and break down of golf and life skills program equipment and supplies
  - Delivery of golf and life skills instruction to participants
- Actively engage, assist, and mentor youth participants
- Serve as a model of mature, responsible behavior to participants
- Foster relationships with participants, while serving as a role model
- Encourage a fun and learning environment
- Display an interest in the development of youth
- Dress professionally (proper golf attire)
- Lesson plan review prior to the start of class
- An appreciation for the game of golf and its inherent life lessons
- Must have flexibility and transportation to work at various programming sites
- Must be available between the hours of 7:30am-3:30pm Monday through Thursday (during the months of June-End of August)

Your hours of work will depend on the number of classes and the class schedules at your site. The number of weekly hours will vary and cannot be guaranteed.

Off-site work is not authorized and will not be compensated, unless approved in advance by the Program Director. This position is not eligible for health benefits; or other full-time TFTGC benefits.
