



The Ace College Scholarship

Application Deadline: Upon Completion of ACE Project

Overview:

The Ace College Scholarship Committee will be awarding secondary education scholarships to students who have actively participated in the First Tee - Greater Charlotte (FTGC) programs and exemplify knowledge and application of The First Tee Life Skills Curriculum, The First Tee Nine Core Values, and The First Tee Nine Healthy Habits.

Participant Selection:

A minimum of one (1) \$3,000 scholarship will be awarded each year. The total number of scholarships offered will be at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee. Following the closing date of May 15, the Scholarship Committee will review written applications and then select candidates for *in-person interviews with the committee*. Award winner(s) will be selected and notified by July 1, 2021.

Eligibility:

For participants of the First Tee - Greater Charlotte to be eligible to apply for The Ace College Scholarship, they must meet ALL of the following requirements:

- Must have been a participant in the First Tee - Greater Charlotte for at least two years at the time of application
- Must be registered in the Participant Database as ACE in the Life Skills Experience at time of application
- Must be registered, active and current in programming at The First Tee of Greater Charlotte
- Must be a high school senior for 2020-2021 school year
- Must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 grading scale
- Must be planning to attend an accredited college or university as a full-time student for 2020-2021 school year
- Must turn in application with completed ACE project
- *If an applicant is a FTGC Alumni, maximum eligibility for a "first time" scholarship application is two years after graduating from high school and still active with the program in the form of volunteering as schedule permits*

If selected, scholarship winner(s) must commit to:

- Must maintain a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 grading scale or higher
- *Must commit to at least 20 volunteer hours with First Tee - Greater Charlotte for the duration of the school year*
- *Winners must re-apply and meet the above criteria for their scholarship to be renewed*
- *Money will be dispersed upon receiving ACE Certification from First Tee Headquarters*
